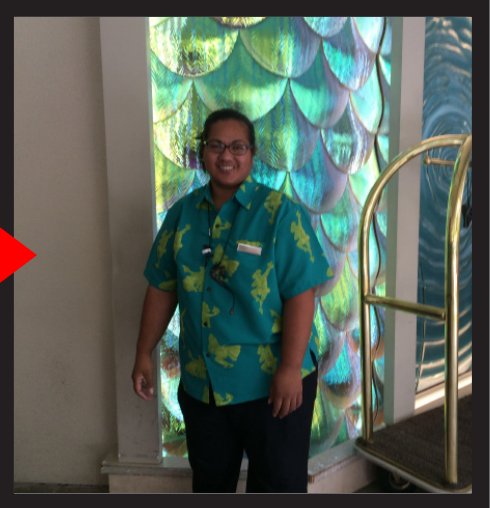

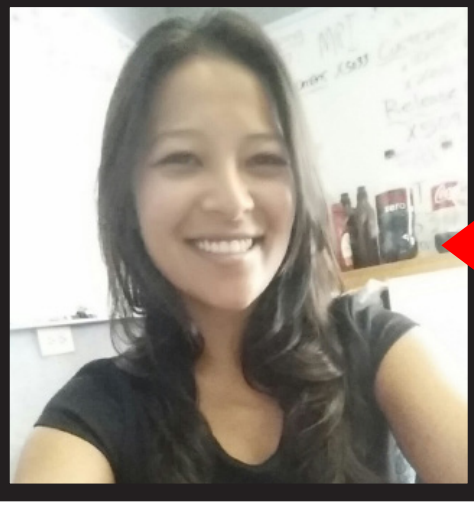

They were guests on KNDI radio, hosted by Sheraton Waikiki worker Nathaniel Felicitas, where they talked about their fight for a fair process to decide whether to unionize.



Jazzmin Aio works in the appointment/receptionist department at Kaiser Honolulu. Kaiser failed to let her know that the position she was applying for was temporary. She filed a grievance with the Contract Enforcement Team, and Kaiser agreed to award her a higher-grade position.

HCC workers at the Hilton Hawaiian Village were featured in a Civil Beat news article. These workers were not paid the union wage rate from 2007-2013, totaling over \$1.5 million in lost wages. These workers have filed a grievance against HHV with the Contract Enforcement Team.
