### CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be a legal permanent resident for at least 5 years or if you are married to a U.S. citizen, you must have been a legal permanent resident for 3 years
- Must have basic knowledge of US government and history
- Must be able to read, write, speak and understand basic English
- Must have a good moral character
- Applicants are responsible for the \$725 filing/fingerprints fee (but may be eligible to apply for a government fee waiver).
- Personal checks or money orders are payable to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).
- Applicants may delay actual payment of application fee to DHS but still get help in completing the N-400 application form.

# DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION NEEDED

- ☐ \$725 check or money order payable to:  
DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY  
or file a fee waiver application.

## IDENTIFICATION

- ☐ Driver's license or state-issued I.D.
- ☐ Lawful permanent residency ("Green") card
- ☐ Passport from home country if available  
(but not required)

## TRIPS OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES (month/day/year)

- ☐ Dates of all trips, over 24 hours, outside of  
the United States in the last five years.
- ☐ Reason for trip and destination.

## RESIDENCE (last 5 years) month and year

- ☐ Complete addresses for the past five years.
- ☐ Dates moved in and moved out of the  
residence.

## EMPLOYMENT (last 5 years) month and year

- ☐ Names, dates and addresses of all  
employers for the past five years.
- ☐ Title of position held.

## SELECTIVE SERVICE (Males only)

- ☐ Selective Service number & date registered

  2. If you have not registered and are between  
the ages of 18 and 26, register by calling  
(847) 688-6888.

### Present spouse:

If your spouse was previously married,  
the same information is required about

- ☐ If child is a legal permanent resident,  
child's green card number
- ☐ City and state of where they live

## CRIMINAL RECORD

- ☐ Date and location of any arrest
- ☐ Nature of the offense
- ☐ Outcome of the case
- ☐ Police report and court disposition
